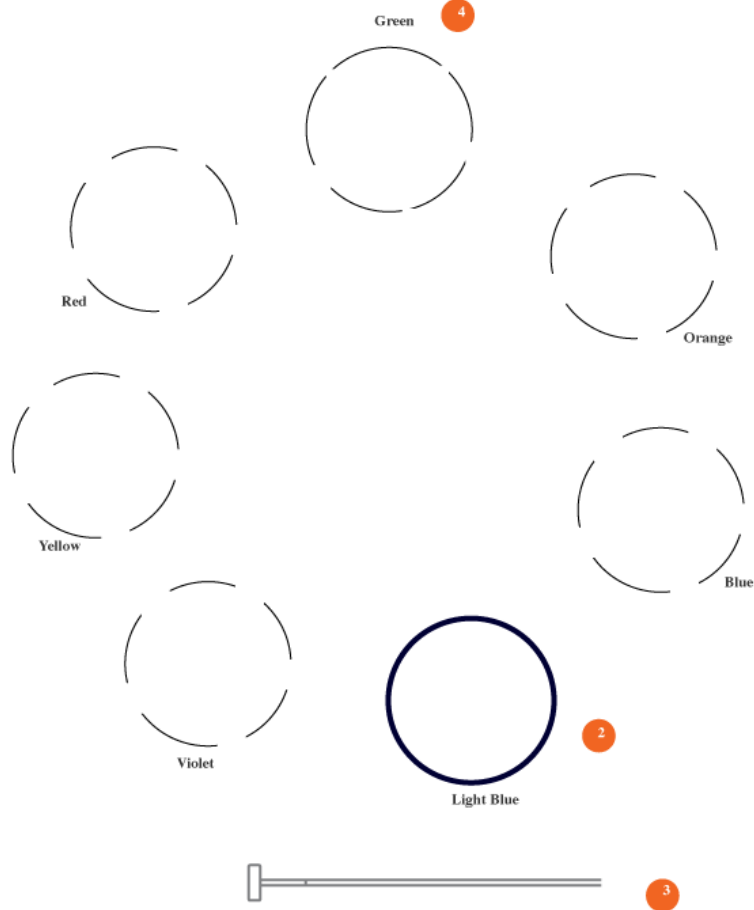


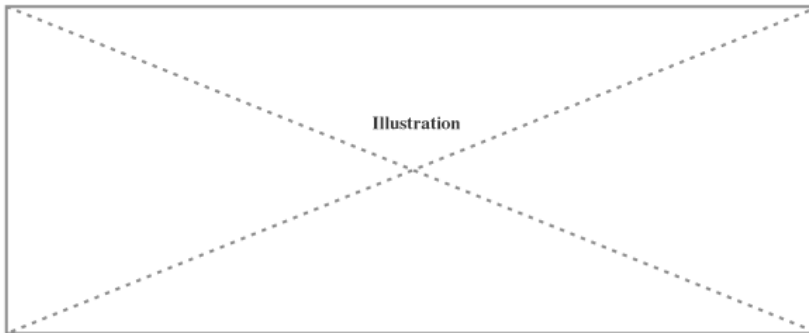
Technology and the 7 Deadly Sins

Annotations:

- 1 The width of the main content area is 960px and is centered in the browser.
- 2 Seven buttons are shown here, which serve as the navigation. Additional buttons can be added as needed. No label will be provided only a color assigned to the button (shown above.) When a button is selected the appearance of the button will change, a thick ring will appear around the item.
- 3 The carousel style navigation can also be controlled using a slider to change the direction of rotation.
- 4 Color names are for illustration purposes, navigation will be based on the users' color choice instead of by name and the position of the navigation will be non-linear.
- 5 Utility navigation appears in the upper right corner, shape of the button differs from main navigation to provide distinction.
- 6 Footer area will contain copyright and disclaimer.

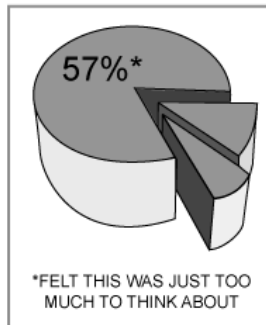

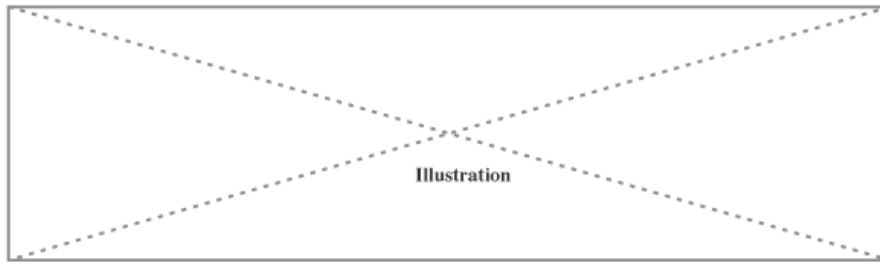

- 6 Export Quiz - Module: Email custom quiz URL or post to social networking site. Preview: displays the query results and URL.
